

Initial Infrastructure: Utilized existing facilities at the Imphal Art College, Government Dance College, and Government Music College. Activities:OffersBA, MA&PhD courses in disciplines like English, Manipuri, Culture Studies, Umanglai Haraoba, Sanskritana Dance, Music, Thang-Ta, Theatre, Tribal Studies, and Visual Arts. Status: A recognized state public university and a teaching and affiliating university under the Government of Manipur.






Ishing Poon Lamjel


